

'To Japan, With Love' Charity Program

Purpose

'To Japan, With Love' is a charity program that aims to gather corporate companies to merge together for a cause dedicated to the Japan Earthquake and Tsunami Fund set up by the Malaysian Red Crescent Society. The fund will be used to help lift the hardships faced by victims struck by the natural disaster and facilitate development programs to rebuild the affected areas in Miyagi and Fukushima prefectures.

Event Overview

The event has THREE components:

1. 100km run at Sundown Ultramarathon on the 25th June 2011
2. Corporate Sponsorship
3. Individual Pledge

missJewelz runs 'To Japan, With Love' at Sundown Ultramarathon on the 25th June 2011

The runner, Nor Juliana Ali or friendlier known as missjewelz in the local running and blogging community will be running her maiden 100km at the Sundown Ultramarathon 2011, Singapore. Juliana is an amateur triathlete who has completed numerous sporting events including Ironman Langkawi, Powerman Malaysia and recently the Sabah Adventure Challenge where she came in 4th for her category after completing 70km tough extreme racing over 2 days in Tambunan, Sabah. She is also the first Malaysian woman to cross the finish line for her category at the event this year.

She will be taking on her next challenge in Singapore at the Sundown Ultramarathon 2011. It is the first time such distance is held at any road running events in Asia. Juliana, a former member of Team Powerbar Elite has also been invited to join an adventure team based in Singapore for an extremely challenging 6 days international adventure race, The Wulong Mountain Quest in Wulong, China in September this year.

The full-time working person and avid blogger who believes in the motto 'Sports for All' would like to initiate this cause of giving back through her sporting activities. Her blog which has received more than 235,000 hits is used to relay this message to the general public, locally and even internationally. The Sundown Ultramarathon 2011 will be used as a start to many more 'giving back' programs. She hopes that contributors can open their hearts for Japan and aid in rebuilding the country-nation in any way they can. Sponsoring and pledging based on each kilometer covered by the runner during the run is targeted to raise some RM500,000 for the fund. Companies donating will have the privilege of tax exemption, granted by this program's partner, Malaysian Red Crescent Society (MRCS).

SPONSORSHIP PACKAGES

Corporate Sponsorship

In support of this charity cause, corporate companies are invited to sponsor a minimal distance of 1km with a pledge valued RM5,000. There is no limit to how many kilometers a sponsor can pledge. The runner aims to finish the run within the cutoff of 16 hours, to which each kilometer, hour and second ran is worth in improving and enhancing the lives of victims affected by the natural disaster. A tax exemption receipt will be given out accordingly to sponsoring companies by the Malaysian Red Crescent Society upon donation transfer.

Individual Sponsorship Package

Individuals are also invited to donate, with a minimum of a meter (1m) pledge worth of RM50 . There is no limit to how many kilometers an individual can pledge.

Kilau Suria Sports

Kilau Suria Sports will be hosting the pledge page. Donations information will be updated on the website accordingly. The runner's training; pre race and race updates will be relayed through the website, Twitter and YouTube. Logos and links to Corporate sponsors' website will also be included in the website.

The website will also include an interactive forum and chat applet to make it more interactive with the rest of the community, especially the running and blogging community of Malaysia, and either wise.

Kilau Suria Sports will stop the pledge on the 15th of June 2011.
